



Instructions:

Customizing screensaver and loading splash images on roulette.

Step1: Upgrade POPE to version 3.6 or later(you can check your POPE version on bottom left). To upgrade click on Help->Check For Updates...



If a new version exists Pope will download it automatically.



Just confirm with Yes to install the update now and follow the on screen instructions(usually pressing 'Next', 'Install', 'Finish'). Check if the update was successful by comparing new version number to the old one...

Note: If you experience problems with 'Check for updates...' or the auto update does not work..., please download Pope update manually from:


Note: If you do not have Pope already installed you can install it by downloading installation package from:


The installation may also need an update, so after installing always do a 'Check for updates..', or manually update..

Step2: Connect to roulette by pressing [+] sign. Enter password on Pope authentication dialog.

Step3: After successful login, double click on 'Administration'. On top select 'Page2'. Download current screensaver image by pressing the button 'Get Current Screensaver'. A dialog will pop up asking you where to save the file. Select a folder of your choice(usually Desktop.); you may leave the filename as suggested RouletteScreensaver.png and click 'Save'.





Step4: Open the downloaded file(\\Desktop\RouletteScreensaver.png) with an image editor of your choice. I use CorelPhoto Paint(but also Adobe Fireworks or Photoshop or GIMP will do). Change the image so that you do not change the format and width or height. Save the file. You can even change filename, just make sure to save the image in same format as source(IT MUST BE PNG 24BIT!! - Check image format with windows right click->properties->Summary).



Note: Screensaver slides are stored all in one image file. The file is $N \times 1024$ pixels in width and 768 pixels in height; where N is the number of slides in screensaver. You may change number of slides, just make sure that your new image width is a multiple of 1024. So, slides begins with pixels: 0(slide1), 1024(slide2), 2048(slide3), 3072(slide4),... Number of slides is limited to below 20 slides.

Step5: Upload the new created file back to roulette by pressing 'Set New Screensaver'. A file select dialog will appear; use it to pick the file you just created ([\\Desktop\RouletteScreensaver_NEW.png](#)). Click Open to select the file. Wait for the transfers to complete(a few black windows will appear and close automaticaly).



Step6: Restart playboards by selecting Administration->Page1->RestartStations. Wait for playboards to restart or manually cycle power. !!To check the screensaver you must payout all credits on one station and wait about 2 minutes for screensavers to begin!!

Step7: Restart from Step3 to correct if something went wrong...

Note: Similar procedure applies for customizing LoadingSplash image. Just Press 'Get Current Loading Splash', modify the image and put it back on roulette with 'Set New Loading Splash'. Wait for the transfer to complete(black window closes – transfer should finish in few seconds) and click 'Retry'.
